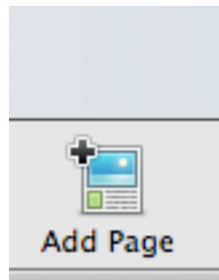


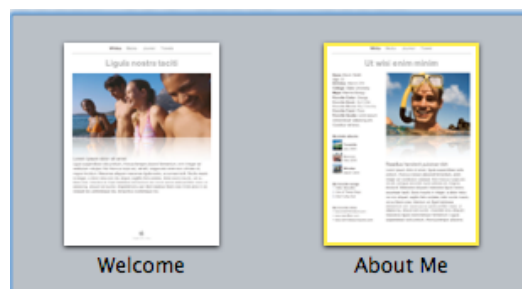
## Making your About Me Page

### ➤ Adding a New Page

Once you have iWeb open, you will see an “Add Page” option in the bottom left corner of the iWeb window. Click it, and you will see the types of new pages you can add. In older versions of iWeb there was a “+” symbol instead of the Add Page icon.



### ➤ Choose the About Me template page for your design.



### ➤ On About Me templates, there are fields for quick information about yourself. Change the example information to things about you.

You can delete any item that you don't want to use for yourself.

- Write an Autobiography of at least 200 words (in a legible fashion). Your biography should include:
  - An explanation of who your parents are.
  - Where you were born and where you have lived as you grew up.
  - What school(s) you've gone to.
  - Where you have traveled/ what your interests and hobbies are.
  - Any other interesting or important facts about you.
  - Hint: you can do a word count by copying and pasting your text in Microsoft Word.
  
- Insert Photos of yourself

You can use photos from home through iPhoto, or you can use Photo Booth to take a picture now.

Open Photo Booth from the applications menu if it is not in your dock already.



Take at least one good photo of yourself, using effects that do not obscure your face.

You can add it to your About Me page by dragging it in.
