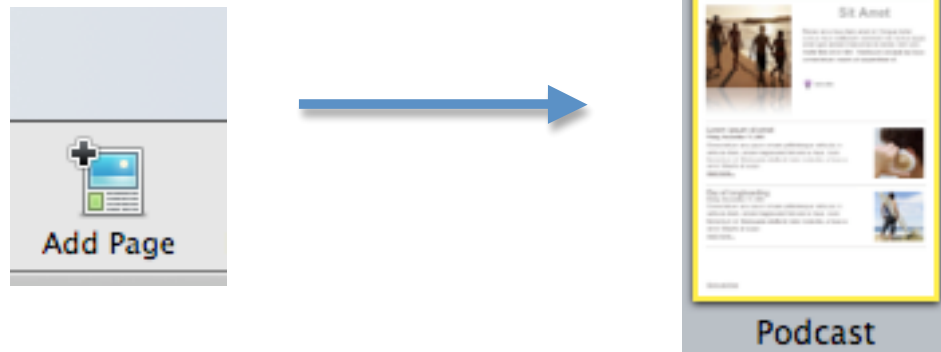
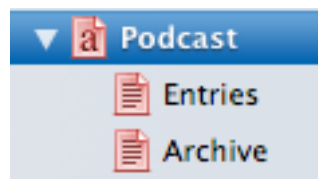


## Making your Learning at Elsa Podcast Page

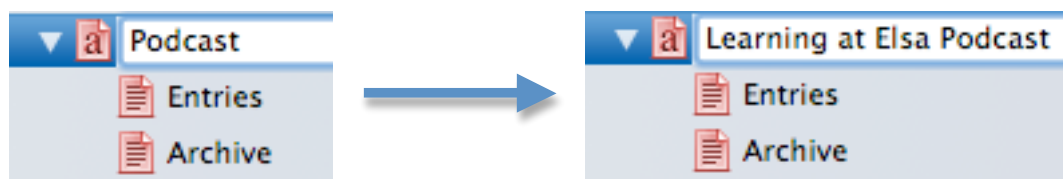
- Open iWeb and add a podcast page to your site:



- The Podcast pages operate similarly to the blog you added last time:

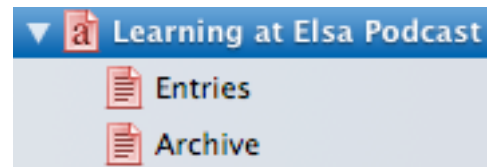


- Podcast page (highlighted above)
    - This is the visible layout of your Podcast page
    - It contains a region for your Podcast Entries and a link to your Archive
    - You edit the look of your Podcast page here, but do not make actual podcast entries.
  - Entries page
    - You must have this page selected to create new (or edit old) entries. You do not edit entries on the main Podcast page.
  - Archive
    - You do not need to edit the Archive. It will work by itself. When you have many entries, older ones will only be accessible to your readers through the Archive link.
- Rename your Podcast page by single-clicking the word Blog and typing the new name in:



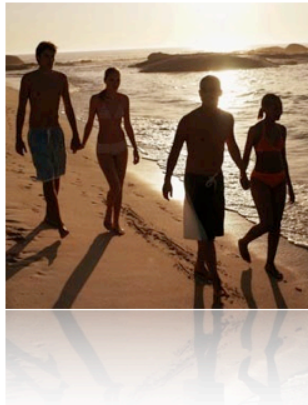
➤ Edit your Blog page:

- Make sure your Podcast page is selected:



- Edit only the top portion of the blog page. Do not delete the Archive link; or the Entries area.

## My Podcast

Change the title; and add an introductory message as below

- The title must be: Learning at Elsa Podcast
- The message must welcome the reader to the Podcast and explain what types of podcasts the reader will find. For example:

“Welcome to my Learning at Elsa podcast. Entries in this Podcast will be about activities in my classes at Elsa, that I hope you find as interesting and exciting as I do.

Each podcast will:

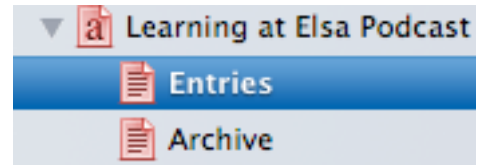
- show me or one of my classmates performing a subject related task;
- will contain an audio explanation of the nature of the task, its goal, and its importance to the subject.
- contain onscreen headings, subtitles, and/or labels to identify different aspects of the podcast.
- Be a ‘finished’ product in terms of editing transitions and affects.”

➤ Create an introduction entry in iMovie:

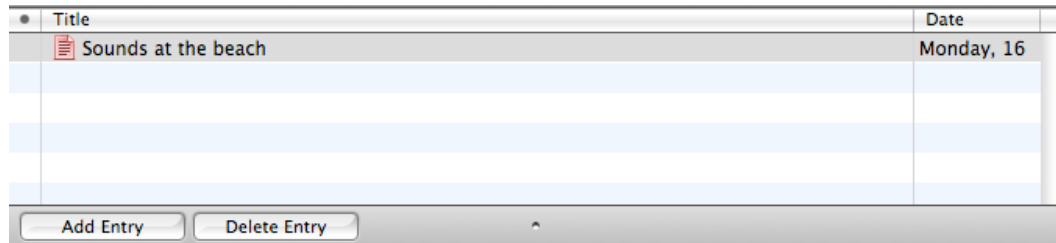
- This entry will be a ‘trial’ entry, meaning that you will create it in iMovie with no (or very little) instruction on how to use iMovie.
- In this podcast you must introduce yourself and your podcast page in a similar way to the paragraph introduction above.
- Hints:
  - In iMovie you can record directly from your iSight camera
  - You can add a simple ‘Ken Burns’ effect to zoom in (or out) of still images you add to your video.
  - Save your file whenever you have something that you like.
  - Remember the power of the undo command.

- Back In iWeb

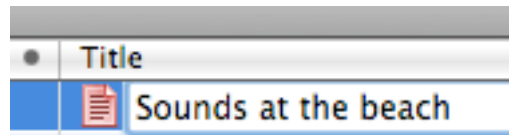
- Select the Entries Page



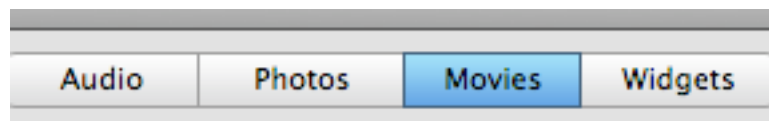
- iWeb gives you a first entry to modify. For future entries you will have to click the Add Entry button to begin.



- Change the name of the entry to be about your Podcast Introduction:



- Change the Picture to be about your Podcast Page or Website
- Delete the sample text, and replace it with your own description.
- Your description must entice your viewer to play the podcast.
- Select the Movies tab from your Media Bar



- Drag your video onto the sample podcast in your entry.
